# Q) Since the "Fellowship" is chartered in Texas, is my credentials recognized anywhere else?

A) Yes, your credentials are recognized in any state in the U.S. In fact we have ministers in Canada and many other countries throughout the world, their credentials are recognized there as well.

# Q) What about performing marriages, funerals, and other ministerial duties?

A) As an Ordained Minister, you may perform marriage ceremonies, funerals, or any other function of an Ordained Minister, such as going into hospitals, nursing homes, prisons, and jails, in accordance with State law.

**Note**: Some states require you to pre-register before performing any wedding ceremonies. Be sure to check with your local Marriage License Bureau.

If for any reason the Board should not accept your application, your money will be refunded to you.

# MINISTERIAL CREDENTIALS AVAILABLE FOR GOD CALLED MEN AND WOMEN!

God has always called, equipped, and raised up leaders among his people to proclaim his Word and to do his Will.

"When Jesus saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion because they were like sheep without a shepherd, and he said, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few! # **PRACTICALITY**

Qualifications

- 1. You must be saved or born again as II Cor. 5:17 says, "Therefore, if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new." We expect our ministers to be free from lust, greed, bitterness, anger, and pride. We all must keep our old flesh nature crucified according to Galatians 2:20. We require a person to be saved or reclaimed a minimum of 2 years.
- 2. God gave not the Spirit by measure to Jesus (John. 3:34) and every Christian has a measure of the Spirit of God. Rom. 8:9. But the Baptism into the Holy Spirit is separate and subsequent to salvation. Acts. 8:14-16; Acts. 19:2; Ephesians. 1:13. A survey of the Acts of the Apostles shows that the common pattern of experience when believers receive the Gift of the Holy Spirit, is that they speak with other tongues. (Acts 2, 8, 9, 10, and 19), which builds up faith (Jude 20) and brings more power (Acts 1:8).
- 3. A person of good moral character and conduct, abstaining from all sexual activity outside of marriage. I Thess. 5:22. We expect our ministers to refrain from gossip, evil speaking, back-biting, and sowing discord among the brethren. In other words, living a life that reflects Jesus.
- 4. You must be definitely called by God into the ministry, with a strong desire to serve others for Christ's sake. Isaiah. 6:1-8; Matt. 28:19,20; Acts. 5:20; Acts. 13:1-4; Acts. 26:16-18. Evidence of a divine calling is a vision for God's work, and anointing of God's presence, and a burden to feed his lambs and sheep. If you have a desire to be used of God, out of the motivation of love, for the Glory of God, behold, you Are Called of God. If in doubt, pray and wait until you're sure.
- 5. You should be active, for actions speak louder than words. You ought to be doing something more than praying, reading your Bible, and going to Church; all Christians should be doing that. The ministry is also much more than standing behind a pulpit delivering sermons to a congregation. The Church needs Sunday School teachers, musicians, alter workers, home and hospital visitors, phone counselors and prayer warrior's and personal workers to witness in public. As their pastor, you need to be behind them, encouraging them to move forward. You could produce and or distribute Christian literature, carry on rest home, jail, and prison ministries, perform good works such as feeding the poor, clothing the needy, conducting home prayer meetings, preaching on radio and T.V. The opportunities of meeting the needs of people everywhere are unlimited!

#### **ORDINATION PROCEDURE**

If you live near Dallas, Texas we would love to have you come to one of our services for a "laying on of hands" Ordination service. We also have Official Representatives throughout much of the United States, that you can go to their church. We will give you their phone number and you can work out the details for your Ordination Service. (You should bless them with some kind of offering). You will be presented with a beautiful certificate that you may frame and hang on your wall, and also a nice card to carry in your wallet. The pocket card will make you eligible for clearance into most jails, prisons, and hospitals, regardless of visiting hours, and some places without paying a parking fee. You will have the same legal status as any other clergy in the country.

We require a One Hundred Twenty Five Dollar Offering (\$125.00) be given by each applicant to help with the expenses of the Fellowship. If a husband and wife both wish Ordination, the Ordination Fee would be only \$200.00 for both. There is also an Annual Renewal Fee of \$60.00 each per year.

VNTFI sponsors several orphanages in Pakistan and Mexico. We have helped Honduran people and Philippine churches. We feed the hungry people in our community on a regular basis. We have several prisoners that we work with. Some have Tent Meetings in the summer and have been very successful doing that.

We have a Pledge Club each month called (<u>Burden Bearers</u>), for the support of these programs. We feel this is a way of helping others the way Jesus commanded us to do. Thank you for becoming one of us.
